FAITH FORMATION

In our series of bulletin posts highlighting different classrooms, we now work our way over to our 5th, 6th, and 7th graders. We always accept new students, and our program is FREE! Email Andy Follaco at andrew.follaco@dor.org.

This class is filled and our classroom shines with bright, inquisitive and faith filled students. Our yearly goal is to live a Catholic life, not just on Sundays, but seven days a week. This allows us to function as a beacon of Catholic life to others. We have a three-year program and this year we are focusing on The Ten Commandments of God and the Six Commandments of the church. While it is important to understand what the Commandments forbid, it is equally important to understand what they command and encourage us to do in our daily lives. We are learning how the Commandments guide us in our faith and how they are all related to each other. One of our greatest concepts this year involves an understanding of how the Commandments intertwine with each other and how a violation of one commandment might also be an offense against another. But mostly we emphasize what we can do to make these Commandments come alive. To do this we combine our studies with what God and the Church wants with lessons on everyday actions inspired by the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy and The Beatitudes. Come and visit our classroom anytime and see our Catholic faith alive in these wonderful soon-to-be young adults. We are also studying the Mysteries of the Rosary and start each class with a decade of prayer. We would love to have you come and pray with us.

CATHOLIC MINISTRIES APPEAL (CMA)

EASTER DUTY

According to the Precepts of the Church, all Catholics over the age of reason (7 years old) must confess their (mortal) sins in the **Sacrament of Penance** at least once a year. They must also receive **Holy Communion** at least once a year during the Easter season, this year extending *from* the I Sunday of Lent (February 18) *until* Trinity Sunday (May 27). The **Easter Duty** of receiving Holy Communion presumes the communicant is in the state of grace (*i.e. not* conscious of mortal sin) AND is not in an irregular state of life (*i.e.* cohabitation or a union not blessed by the Church).

CHURCH ETIQUETTE

WHEN YOU COME TO CHURCH, please turn OFF all cell phones, hand-held electronic devices, pagers, watch alarms, etc., and anything else that can disrupt our sacred time with God. It is possible for messaging and texting to *wait* until later!

DRESS CODE: Please remember to dress appropriately for divine worship: *neatly* and *modestly*. Holy Mass is not an occasion when we "dress down" or appear "super-casual"! REVERENCE for God and RESPECT for neighbor should determine what we wear. Think about it. Thank you for your cooperation.

THERE ARE (AT LEAST) THREE REASONS to maintain a prayerful, quiet atmosphere in the church proper before and after services: (1) RESPECT for the House of God, (2) REVERENCE for the Blessed Sacrament, and (3) REGARD for those who want to pray in peace. The guiding principle should be DEVOTION **NOT** COMMOTION. Please carry on your friendly conversations in the church vestibules (with inside doors closed), outside, or at the coffee hours. Reverence and friendliness can and should co-exist—in their proper settings!!

SPEAKING OF CHURCH ETIQUETTE...

...We should make a determined effort to be *on time* for Mass, and we should make the little sacrifice to stay until Mass is over (that is, when the priest-celebrant leaves the sanctuary). When it becomes necessary to conduct children to the bathroom, please do not travel through the church during the CONSECRATION of the Mass. This will involve only a few moments of delay.
