GUIDELINES FOR COMMUNION

Catholics need to remember the Church's traditional rules on the reception of Holy Communion. Practicing Catholics who are *spiritually prepared* (i.e. not conscious of mortal sin on their souls) may approach the altar rail to make a *worthy* Communion. If one has been away from Masses of Obligation (due to one's own fault) or if there is another reason for being ill prepared, the Sacrament of Penance (Confession) is necessary *before* the reception of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord. We should always approach this awesome Eucharistic Mystery with souls empty of grave sin and *full* of great love. As in the awesome Incarnational Mystery of the Word-made flesh in the stable of Bethlehem, here holy fear and deep love co-mingle.

LENTEN OBSERVANCE (REQUIRED MINIMUM)

- 1. **ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT**: Those who have completed their 14th birthday are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on ALL the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. **FASTING**: Those between the ages of 18 & 59 (inclusive) are also obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In fasting, one is permitted to eat a single full meal and two other small meals which, when added together, do not equal a full meal and no eating between meals.
- OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE: are encouraged according to one's health and generosity with God. The classic Lenten penitential formula is PRAYER, FASTING, and ALMSGIVING (i.e. works of charity and mercy).

WEEKLY NOTICES

SACRAMENT OF PENANCE Today both Father Helfrich and Father Bonsignore will be available for CONFESSIONS, after the Latin Mass. Father Bonsignore will stay until 3pm. This will be an opportunity for you to make a good Confession for Easter and for Divine Mercy Sunday. (The Divine Mercy Confession can be done any time <u>during</u> Lent.)

THE ADORATION CHAPEL will <u>not</u> be open for visitation this week on Holy Thursday and Good Friday.

EASTER SUNDAY MASSES will be at the usual times: English at 9am, and Latin at 11:15am. The Latin Mass will be a HIGH MASS.
