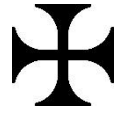

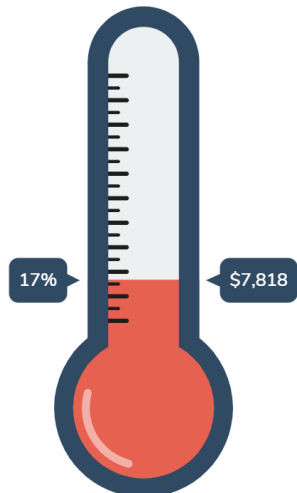

GUIDELINES FOR COMMUNION

CATHOLICS NEED TO REMEMBER the Church's traditional rules on the reception of Holy Communion. Practicing Catholics who are *spiritually prepared* (i.e. not conscious of mortal sin on their souls) may approach the altar rail to make a *worthy* Communion. If one has been away from Masses of Obligation (due to one's own fault) or if there is another reason for being ill prepared, the Sacrament of Penance (Confession) is necessary *before* the reception of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord. We should always approach this awesome Eucharistic Mystery with souls empty of grave sin and *full* of great love. As in the awesome Incarnational Mystery of the Word-made flesh in the stable of Bethlehem, here holy fear and deep love co-mingle.

CATHOLIC COUPLES in cohabitation (living together without the Sacrament of Matrimony) or in irregular marriages (without the blessing of Christ's Sacrament) are advised not to receive Holy Communion. These brothers and sisters of ours are of deep pastoral concern to the Church. Hopefully they will soon take steps to rectify their situation.

WEEKLY NOTICES

THANKSGIVING DAY is coming up on Thursday, November 24. Both English and Latin Masses will be celebrated with music. Every year we alternate the order in which they are offered: this year the first will be the English Mass at 8:30am, and the second will be the Latin Mass at 10:30am..

CMA-2022/2023 By now you have received your package from the Diocese regarding the CMA campaign for 2022/2023. Our goal this year has been raised to \$47,000. This is quite an increase from last year's campaign. We were fortunate after our appeal that the Diocese forgave our shortfall from last year. To meet this year's goal, we will need everyone's support. We are aware that the economy is affecting all of us. We only ask that you do your best whatever it maybe in contributing to the campaign. Your full contribution will not be due until May of 2023. As in the past, any shortfall will be made up by the parish. As mentioned in the past, those that are required to take their minimum distribution from their IRA's, can designate your contribution to the CMA. There is a tax advantage to make your contribution from your IRA. This will result in your contribution to the CMA to be a non-taxable distribution. At the same time, you will not be able to deduct your contribution as a charitable contribution. Please make sure that you indicate our parish number 400, when you complete your paperwork, for this transaction with your financial advisor. You may also use your IRA required distribution to make any other year-end donations to LMC.

THE SECOND READING Col 1:12-20

Brothers and sisters: Let us give thanks to the Father, who has made you fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light. He delivered us from the power of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. For in him were created all things in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers; all things were created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. He is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things he himself might be preeminent. For in him all the fullness was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile all things for him, making

peace by the blood of his cross through him, whether those on earth or those in heaven.

GOSPEL Lk 23:35-43

The rulers sneered at Jesus and said, "He saved others, let him save himself if he is the chosen one, the Christ of God." Even the soldiers jeered at him. As they approached to offer him wine they called out, "If you are King of the Jews, save yourself." Above him there was an inscription that read, "This is the King of the Jews." Now one of the criminals hanging there reviled Jesus, saying, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us." The other, however, rebuking him, said in reply, "Have you no fear of God, for you are subject to the same condemnation? And indeed, we have been condemned justly, for the sentence we received corresponds to our crimes, but this man has done nothing criminal." Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." He replied to him, "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

CREDO I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, *(here all bow)* **AND BY THE HOLY SPIRIT WAS INCARNATE OF THE VIRGIN MARY AND BECAME MAN.** For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins, and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

INTROIT

The Lord says: "I think thoughts of peace, and not of affliction. You shall call upon me, and I will hear you; and I will bring back your captivity from all places." You have favored, O Lord, your land; you have restored the well-being of Jacob. Glory be to the Father. The Lord says.

COLLECT O Lord, stir up the wills of the faithful that they may be more eager to seek the fruits of divine grace, and to discover in your mercy greater healing for their sinfulness. Through Jesus Christ.

EPISTLE Col. 1, 9-14

Brethren: We have been praying for you unceasingly, asking that you may attain full knowledge of God's will through perfect wisdom and spiritual understanding. Thus you will lead a life worthy of the Lord and pleasing to him in every way; you will be fruitful in every kind of good deed and you will grow in the knowledge of God; by the might of his glory you will be endowed with great power to stand fast and endure joyfully whatever may come; and you will give thanks to the Father for making you worthy

to share the lot of the saints in light. For he rescued us from the power of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of his beloved Son, through whom we have redemption and the forgiveness of our sins.

GRADUAL You saved us, O Lord, from our foes, and those who hated us you put to shame. In God we gloried day by day; your name we praised always. Alleluia, alleluia. Out of the depths I cry to you, O Lord; Lord, hear my prayer! Alleluia.

GOSPEL Matth. 24, 15-35

At that time Jesus said to his disciples: "When you see the abominable and destructive thing, which the prophet Daniel foretold, standing upon holy ground (the reader will take note!), then those in Judea must flee to the mountains. If a man is on the roof terrace, he must not go down to get anything out of his house. If a man is in the field, he must not turn back to pick up his cloak. Unhappy the women who are pregnant or nursing their children at that period! Keep praying that you will not have to flee in the winter or on a sabbath. For then, there will be great distress surpassing any since the beginning of the world until now, or any that is to come. Indeed if that period had not been shortened, not a human being would have been saved. However, for the sake of the chosen that period will be shortened. Then, if anyone tells you, 'Look, here is the Messiah!' or 'There he is!' don't believe it. False messiahs and false prophets will appear displaying such great signs and wonders as to mislead (were that possible) even the chosen. Remember, I have foretold this to you. So if they tell you,

'Look, he is in the desert!' don't go out there, or, 'Look, he is hidden in the house!' don't believe it. Just as lightning from the east flashes clear to the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. It is where the dead body lies that the eagles will gather. Immediately after the distress of that period, 'the sun will be darkened, the moon will not shed her light, the stars will fall out of the sky, the hosts of heaven will be shaken loose.' And then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, 'while

all the clans of earth' will strike their breasts when they see 'the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven' with power and great glory. He will dispatch his angels 'with a mighty trumpet blast and they will assemble his chosen from the four winds, from one horizon to the other.' Learn a lesson from the example of the fig-tree. Once its branch becomes tender and sprouts leaves, you realize that summer is near. Likewise, when you see all these things, you will realize that he is near, standing at your door. I assure you, the men of today will not pass away before all these things happen. Heaven and earth will pass away; my words will never pass away."

SECRET O Lord, lend a responsive ear to our petitions. Receive the offerings and prayers of your people, and turn the hearts of us all toward yourself, so that we may be drawn from earthly desires to the joys of heaven. Through Jesus Christ.

COMMUNION Amen I say to you, all things whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you shall receive, and it shall be done to you.

POST COMMUNION O Lord, cure the evil in our hearts by the healing power of the sacrament we have received. Through Jesus Christ.

CHURCH ETIQUETTE

WHEN YOU COME TO CHURCH please turn OFF all cell phones, hand-held electronic devices, pagers, watch alarms, etc., and anything else that can disrupt our sacred time with God. It is possible for emails and texts to *wait* until later!

DRESS CODE Please remember to dress appropriately for divine worship: neatly and modestly. Holy Mass is not an occasion when we "dress down" or appear "super-casual"! REVERENCE for God and RESPECT for neighbor should determine what we wear. Think about it. Thank you for your cooperation.

THERE ARE (AT LEAST) THREE REASONS to maintain a prayerful, quiet atmosphere in the church proper before and after services: (1) RESPECT for the House of God, (2) REVERENCE for the Blessed Sacrament, and (3) REGARD for those who want to pray in peace. The guiding principle should be DEVOTION NOT COMMOTION. Please carry on your friendly conversations in the church vestibules (with inside doors closed), outside, or at the coffee hours. Reverence and friendliness can and should co-exist—in their proper settings!

IN ADDITION ...We should make a determined effort to be *on time* for Mass, and we should make the little sacrifice to stay until Mass is over (that is, when the priest-celebrant leaves the sanctuary). When it be necessary to conduct children to the bathroom, please do not travel through the church during the CONSECRATION of the Mass. This will involve only a few moments of delay.

THE SAINT MICHAEL PRAYER (Pope Leo XIII)

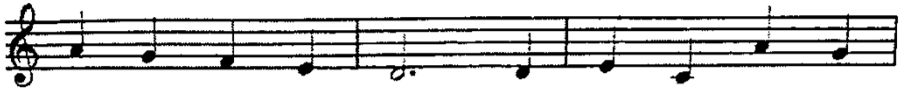

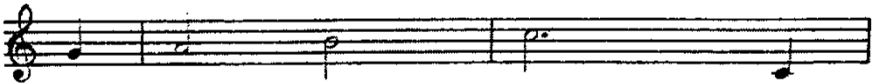

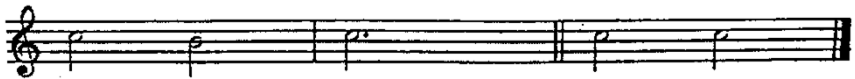
