CHRISTMAS: A TIME FOR HOMECOMING

Once again, the Church, our alma Mater (loving Mother), invites us to welcome our Infant King into our hearts. She also calls her absent and distant sons and daughters to "come home" to the family of God, the household of faith gathering in the House of the Lord.

Catholic returnees need to remember the Church's traditional rules on the reception of Holy Communion. Practicing Catholics who are *spiritually prepared* (i.e. not conscious of mortal sin on their souls) may approach the altar rail to make a *worthy* Communion. If one has been away from Masses of Obligation (due to one's own fault) or if there is another reason for being ill prepared, the Sacrament of Penance (Confession) is necessary *before* the reception of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord. We should always approach this awesome Eucharistic Mystery with souls empty of grave sin and *full* of great love. As in the awesome Incarnational Mystery of the Word-made flesh in the stable of Bethlehem, here holy fear and deep love co-mingle.
