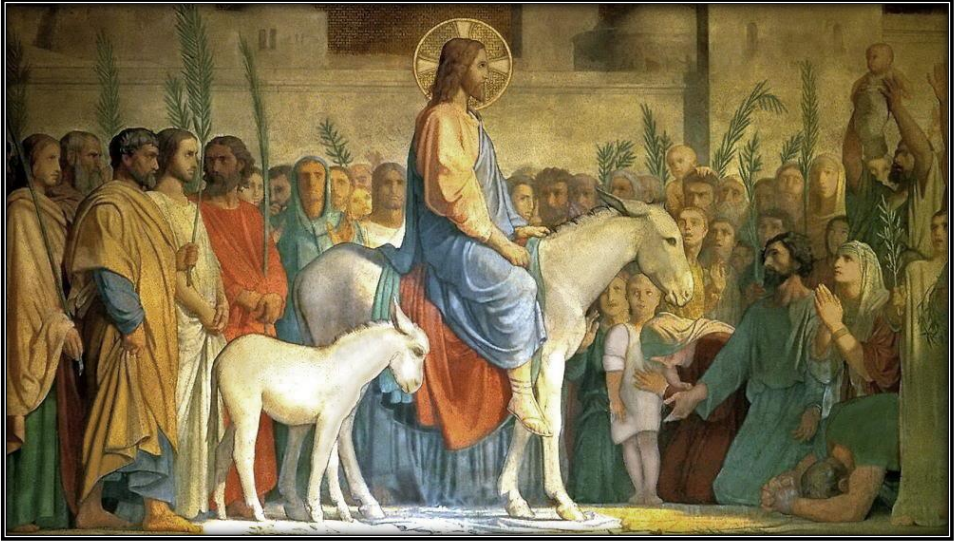
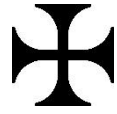

NEWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

LENTEN OBSERVANCE (REQUIRED MINIMUM)

- ✠ **ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT:** Those who have completed their 14th birthday are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on ALL the Fridays of Lent.
- ✠ **FASTING:** Those between the ages of 18 & 59 (inclusive) are also obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In fasting, one is permitted to eat a single full meal and two other small meals which, when added together, do not equal a full meal and no eating between meals.
- ✠ **OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE:** are encouraged according to one's health and generosity with God. The classic Lenten penitential formula is PRAYER, FASTING, and ALMSGIVING (i.e. works of charity and mercy).

TODAY At both Masses, we will have the traditional Blessing of Palms and Procession.

EASTER SUNDAY MASSES will be at the usual times; English 9am and Latin 11:15am.

EASTER EGG HUNT Friends and family of SKT-LMC are invited to bring their children ages 0-10 for our annual Easter Egg Hunt on Holy Saturday 4/4/26. Please gather on the steps on the South side of the church starting at 9:45am; the hunt starts promptly at 10:00am. We thank the Knights of Columbus Msgr. Richard K. Burns Council for sponsoring this joyous annual event.

THE ADORATION CHAPEL will NOT be open for visitation this week on Holy Thursday and Good Friday.

UPCOMING LATIN HIGH MASSES WILL BE:

April 5 Easter, April 26 Third Sunday after Easter, May 24 Pentecost

CMA 2025-2026 UPDATES through 3/24 (50) donors pledged \$17,195 which is 35% of the goal.

THE SECOND & THIRD PRECEPTS (COMMANDMENTS/LAWS) of the CHURCH: All Catholics who have reached the age of reason must confess their (mortal) sins in the Sacrament of Penance at least once a year. They must also receive Holy Communion at least once each year during the Easter season, which this year extends from the First Sunday of Lent until Trinity Sunday, May 31. The Easter duty of receiving Holy Communion presumes the communicant is in the state of grace (i.e. without mortal sins).

DIVINE MERCY DEVOTIONS will be held again this year on Low (Mercy) Sunday, April 12 after the Latin Mass. In connection with the Divine Mercy Devotion, it is advisable and appropriate to receive the Sacrament of Penance during Lent and before the Mercy celebration.

THE SECOND READING Phil 2:6-11

Christ Jesus, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

GOSPEL Lk 22:14—23:56

The Passion of our Lord is read aloud, not printed here.

CREDO I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, *(here all bow)* **AND BY THE HOLY SPIRIT WAS INCARNATE OF THE VIRGIN MARY AND BECAME MAN.** For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins, and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

INTROIT Psalms 21: 20, 22

COLLECT Almighty and everlasting God, by whose ordinance our Savior took flesh and suffered crucifixion to give mankind a pattern of humility, grant us this boon, that, with the lesson of His endurance before us, we may be found worthy to have fellowship in His resurrection: Through the same Jesus Christ, Thy Son, our Lord, Who lives and reigns with Thee in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever.

EPISTLE Philippians 2: 5-11

Brethren: yours is to be the same mind which Christ Jesus showed. His nature is, from the first, divine, and yet He did not see, in the rank of Godhead, a prize to be coveted; He dispossessed Himself, and took the nature of a slave, fashioned in the likeness of men, and presenting Himself to us in human form; and then He lowered His own dignity, accepted an obedience which brought Him to death, death on a cross. That is why God has raised Him to such a height, given Him that name which is greater than any other name; (Here all kneel.) So that everything in heaven and on earth and under the earth must bend the knee before the name of Jesus, and every tongue must confess Jesus Christ as the Lord, dwelling in the glory of God the Father.

GRADUAL Thou dost hold me by my right hand: Thine to lead me in a way of Thy own choosing, Thine to take me up to Thyself in glory. What bounty God shows to Israel, to all upright hearts! Yet I came near to losing my foothold, and felt the ground sink under my steps, so indignant was I over the good fortune of the sinners that flout His law.

TRACT My God, my God, look upon me: why have you forsaken me? Far from my salvation, are the words of my sins. O my God, I cry out by day and you answer not; by night, and there is no relief. But you are enthroned in the holy place, O glory of Israel! In you our fathers trusted; they trusted and you delivered them. To you they cried, and they escaped; in you they trusted, and they were not put to shame. But I am a worm, not a man; the scorn of men, despised by the people. All who see me, scoff at me; they mock me with parted lips, they wag their heads. Y. "He relied on the Lord; let him deliver him, let him rescue him, if he loves him." But they look on and gloat over me; they divide my

garments among them, and for my vesture they cast lots. Save me from the lion's mouth; from the horns of the wild bulls, my wretched life. You who fear the Lord, praise him: all you descendants of Jacob, give glory to him. There shall be declared to the Lord a generation to come: and the heavens shall show forth his justice. To a people that shall be born, which the Lord has made.
